

# SOUTHERN MINNESOTA DISASTER RECOVERY CENTER-OWATONNA

### Purpose

The Southern Minnesota Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) has been established to allow the residents and businesses of counties, who have been impacted by the fall floods, access to answers and guidance regarding their uninsured disaster related losses and damages.

Representatives from local, state, federal, and other supporting agencies will provide resources to assist individuals and families in their disaster recovery. These disaster related resources include, but not limited to:

- Small Business Administration (SBA-Home and Business Loan Program)
- Farm advocacy
- Unemployment
- Housing
- Long term recovery assistance
- Emotional support

Persons seeking disaster recovery guidance can stop in to the DRC during hours of operation. They do not need to make an appointment. **FEMA will NOT be participating in this DRC as those individual assistance programs were not made available in this disaster.**
